In 1982, two Williamsport residents traveled to Americus, GA to Habitat for Humanity International Inc. and bought a “How-to Set Up a Habitat Manual” for \$35. They brought the guide back to Williamsport, and together with a handful of dedicated residents and churches, began working to improve living conditions for local low-income families. In 1989, the group successfully became incorporated as an official Habitat for Humanity affiliate. We are proud to say that GLHFH has since successfully built and/or renovated 53 homes, serving more than 225 people including over 100 children. Today, we’ve grown into an organization that mobilizes volunteers to transform lives through access to home improvement materials, affordable housing development, and financial literacy training.

As we reflect on the 30 years of service, we are reminded of how lucky we are to live in such a vibrant and intentional community. Building homes and changing lives has been made possible by the support we have received from our generous donors, devoted volunteers and partner homeowners. We are so thankful for every donation, every ReStore purchase, and every hour of volunteer time invested. Together, we’re building a better community.
